2023 MAY Block of the Month

Use Black ,White **BRIGHT ORANGE** for this block


QUILTING IN THE PINES BLOCK OF THE MONTH – MAY 2012




Black & White & Bright #5

Makes a 12" finished block. When making the block, please use 100% cotton fabric washed and trimmed of selvages before cutting. All blocks should be 12½" square (unfinished) when completed. If your block is a little off, don't square it up. Leave that to the winner who may want to use the same ruler to square all the blocks.

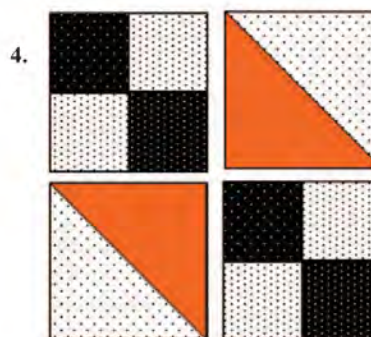
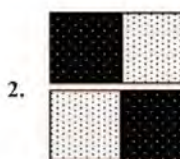
May's Block Instructions

 White-on-blackCut four 3-1/2" squares

 Black-on-white.....Cut four 3-1/2" squares
Cut one 7" square

 Bright orangeCut one 7" square

1. Sew four pairs of 3-1/2" blocks, white-on-black and black-on-white together. Make four.
2. Sew pairs into four-patches. Square up to 6-1/2". Make two.
3. Sew black-on-white and orange 7" squares into half-square triangles. Draw diagonal line corner to corner, sew 1/4" on each side of line and cut on line to make two blocks.
4. **Block Assembly:** Sew the four-patch units and the half-square triangles together, placing the orange as shown.
