## **QUIP BOM 4 – Star- Crossed Roses**

## **Cutting instructions**

Fabric 1 – light blue

Cut (4) 3 ½ inch squares (to be used for center X blocks)

Fabric 2 – black with white accents

Cut (8) 2-inch x 3 ½ inch rectangles

Fabric 3 – light blue

Cut (4) 2-inch squares (to be used for 4 outer corners)

Fabric 4 – white

Cut (8) 2-inch x 3 ½ inch rectangles

Cut (8) 2-inch squares


Fabric 5 – white with black accents

Cut (4) 2-inch squares


Cut (4) 2 x 3 ½ inch rectangles

## **Piecing instructions**

Sew the\_black with white accent rectangles (fabric 2) to the white rectangles (fabric 4). Make 8 pairs.



Sew the 2-inch light blue square (fabric 3) to the 2-inch white with black accent squares (fabric 5). Make 4 units. Then sew those units to the white with black accent rectangles (fabric 5). Make 4 units.




## **QUIP BOM 4 – Star- Crossed Roses**

Sew a white 2-inch square diagonally across opposite corners of the light blue  $3\,\%$  inch square. Trim. Make 4 units

Assemble the 4 quadrants

Sew the quadrants together to form the finished block
