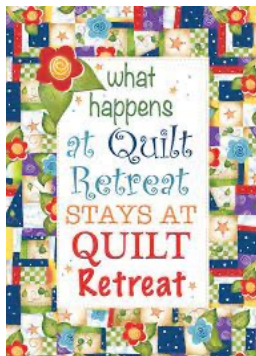

QUILTING IN THE PINES BLOCK OF THE MONTH – DECEMBER 2012

BOM

Black & White & Bright #12

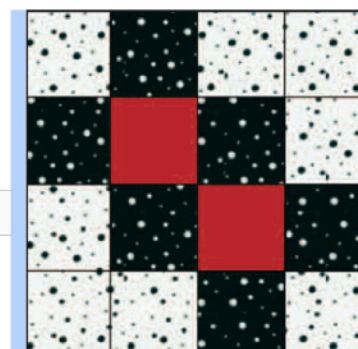
Makes a 12" finished block. When making the block, please use 100% cotton fabric washed and trimmed of selvages before cutting. All blocks should be 12½" square (unfinished) when completed. If your block is a little off, don't square it up. Leave that to the winner who may want to use the same ruler to square all the blocks.

December's Block Instructions

-  White-on-blackCut six 3-1/2" squares
-  Black-on-white.....Cut eight 3-1/2" squares
-  Bright yellowCut two 3-1/2" squares

1. Sew four rows of blocks together as shown.

2. **Block Assembly:** Sew the rows together as shown to make a 12-1/2" block.

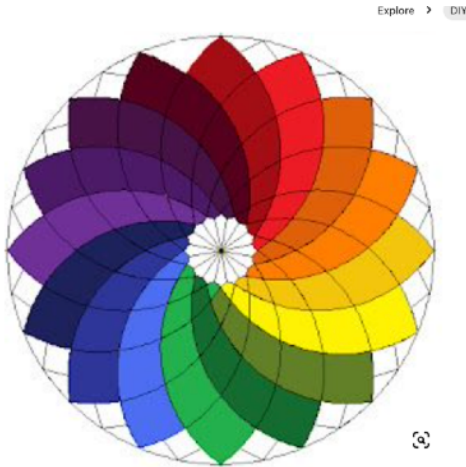
