


2026 February Block of the Month

QUIP's 2026 BOM is a smaller version of A Quilter's Life Log Cabin. **The version that we will be doing for our raffle is below. The completed block is 10" square.** For those that would like to make the 18" block version for their own personal use (the larger version has added pieces), the directions for the outer strips/borders will be sent in an email.

Cutting Instructions

Finished Block is 10"



6" Block (6 1/2" unfinished)	
Medium/Dark (A)	(2) 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles
Light (B)	(2) 3 1/2" squares
Light (C)	(4) 1 1/2" squares

Designer Note: Follow the block guide shown for fabric placement. Units are labeled A-C.




Cutting Instructions for Strips for Block Border


Medium/Dark (A & B)	(1) 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangle labeled as A and (1) 2 1/2" x 10 1/2" rectangle labeled as B
Light (G)	(1) 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangle
Light (H)	(1) 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangle

Piecing Instructions

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (2) B – squares and (4) C – squares using an erasable marker or pencil. Set the C – squares aside for Step 4.
2. Place (2) A – rectangles onto your workstation vertically. Place (1) B – square onto the bottom corner of each A – rectangle, right sides together. Reference the diagram for the orientation of the drawn diagonal line for the left and right sides of the Heart Unit.
3. Sew along the drawn diagonal lines. Trim the excess corner fabric to a 1/4" and press toward the corners.
4. Repeat stitch and flip techniques to attach (1) C – square to both top corners of each A – rectangle to complete the left and right sides of the Heart Unit.



5. Sew the left and right sides of the Heart Unit together to complete the March Block Center. Press the seam to one side. Once complete, the March Block Center should measure 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" unfinished.



- 6.) Sew on remaining strips around center house block in the order shown. Completed block will be 10".
