## DO THIS BLOCK IN. BRIGHT GREEN

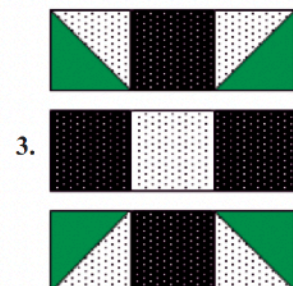
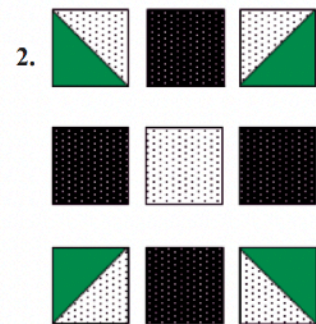
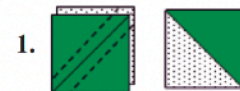
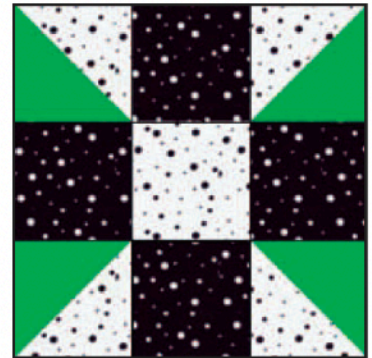
### Black & White & Bright #11

*Makes a 12" finished block. When making the block, please use 100% cotton fabric washed and trimmed of selvages before cutting. All blocks should be 12½" square (unfinished) when completed. If your block is a little off, don't square it up. Leave that to the winner who may want to use the same ruler to square all the blocks.*

#### November's Block Instructions

-  White-on-black .....Cut four 4-1/2" squares
-  Black-on-white.....Cut one 4-1/2" squares  
Cut two 5" squares
-  Bright green .....Cut two 5" squares

1. Sew black on white and green 5" squares into four half-square triangles. Draw diagonal line corner to corner, sew 1/4" on each side of line and cut on line to make four blocks. Square up to 4-1/2".
2. Sew 4-1/2" squares and half-square triangles together as shown. Make three rows.
3. **Block Assembly:** Sew rows together as shown to make a 12-1/2" block.
