# DO THIS BLOCK IN. BRIGHT GREEN

# Black & White & Bright #11

Makes a 12" finished block. When making the block, please use 100% cotton fabric washed and trimmed of selvages before cutting. All blocks should be 12½" square (unfinished) when completed. If your block is a little off, don't square it up. Leave that to the winner who may want to use the same ruler to square all the blocks.


#### **November's Block Instructions**


White-on-black ......Cut four 4-1/2" squares


Black-on-white...........Cut one 4-1/2" squares
Cut two 5" squares

Bright green ......Cut two 5" squares


- 1. Sew black on white and green 5" squares into four half-square triangles. Draw diagonal line corner to corner, sew 1/4" on each side of line and cut on line to make four blocks. Square up to 4-1/2".
- **2.** Sew 4-1/2" squares and half-square triangles together as shown. Make three rows.
- **3. Block Assembly:** Sew rows together as shown to make a 12-1/2" block.
