# Black & White & Bright #9

Makes a 12" finished block. When making the block, please use 100% cotton fabric washed and trimmed of selvages before cutting. All blocks should be 121/2" square (unfinished) when completed. If your block is a little off, don't square it up. Leave that to the winner who may want to use the same ruler to square all the blocks.

#### September's Block Instructions

White-on-black ......Cut four 3-1/2" squares


Black-on-white......Cut four 3-1/2" squares Cut two 4" squares



Bright pink ......Cut four 3-1/2" squares

Cut two 4" squares


- 1. Sew black-on-white and pink 4" squares into four half-square triangles. Draw diagonal line corner to corner, sew 1/4" on each side of the line and cut on line to make two blocks. Square up to 3-1/2".
- 2. Sew 3-1/2" squares together as shown. Make two units.
- 3. Sew 3-1/2" squares and half-square triangles together as shown. Make two units.
- 4. Block Assembly: Sew rows together as shown to make a 12-1/2" block.
