## WALKER BAG

## Materials:

2 Pieces of fabric 15" x 43" (or width of fabric—WOF)

1 Piece of lightweight batting 15" x 43" (same size as fabric)

6" Sew-on Velcro

## Instructions:

- 1. Layer batting, fabric 1 right side up in the middle and fabric 2 right side down on top.
- Sew <sup>1</sup>/4" along all edges leaving about a 4" opening for turning,
- 3. Turn inside out and press.
- 4. Top stitch all around.
- Attach the Velcro. Choose the front and the back. On the back side, pin and sew 3" Velcro tabs. Measure the center (you can always press in half to find the center). Sew the Velcro 5" from the center and 1-1/2" from the sides.
- 6. Fold both ends to make the pockets. Fold the pockets so that they are the same distance from the center. Pocket depth can vary, but generally you want the pockets to come up to the level of the Velcro hiding the stitching underneath. That means the top of the pockets will be 5" from the center of the tote.
- 7. Sew along the sides and center of both sides. Be sure to reinforce the top of the pockets by backstitching that goes well past the edge of the pocket.

Optional: subdividing pockets.
